- 6. Do we really need Gemma be kicked out of the military?

- 8. What if the new cold war is an information warfare and Raphael uses her to get to something. Or she thinks he uses her (I don't like that idea though, because it's a cliche)
- 9. The ending should mirror the first scene with saving Raphael. She decides not to get hurt again, but by her thinking she's doing the right thing, she ends up hurting herself.
